











REGIONAL CONTEXT

WEAK ACCOUNTABILITY:

- Multiple forms of corruption prevent the investment in development projects
- Uncoordinated public procurement
- Weak capacities in public and private organisations
- Insufficient number of magistrates and judges
- Majority of the population, living in rural areas, has poor access to justice

Civil society organisations (CSOs) and the academia struggle with capacity limitations

Independent media

Poor public finance management - the country suffers from an outdated fiscal policy and revenue management

ACCOUNTABILITY INSTITUTIONS:

- Parliament has a limited role in governance
- Anti-Corruption Bureau fails to prosecute effectively major corruption
- Office of the Ombudsman is heavily dependent on donor funding

TEAM EUROPE PROPOSAL

PARTICIPATORY AND INCLUSIVE GOVERNANCE:

- Promoting joint policy and political dialogue on democratic governance
- Empowering citizens (girls and women, civil society, media, private sector) in fighting and reporting the misuse of authority, funds or other of public interest (EU, IE)
- Electoral cycle assistance and support to domestic electoral observation - next presidential election in 2025 (EU, DE tbd)

RULE OF LAW AND JUSTICE:

- Human rights and fundamental freedoms, fight against discrimination in all its forms (EU, DE tbd)
- Improving access to justice and ensuring a responsive and fair justice - reinforcing the capacity of judiciary institutions (EU, IE)
- Accelerating the transformation of public financial management (EU (incl. DRM), DE, IE).
- Enhancing the institutional capacity of independent governance and oversight institutions (EU, DE, IE)
- Improving access to information and using digital tools for enhanced transparency and accountability in the public sector

KEY DELIVERABLES

Good governance Access to Justice

- 1. Digitalisation of the judiciary's case management system, prisoners' registry and police information system
- 2. Construction / rehabilitation of prison facilities, victim support units and magistrate courts in underserviced areasMigration: a structured dialogue on migration issues.

Participatory governance

- 3. Expansion and maintenance of electronic civil registration, linking the eID to public services
- 4. Security of IT tools in the electoral process, in particular for results and incidents transmission

Economic governance

5. Digitalisation of case management and coordination in anti-corruption

TRANSFORMATIONAL POTENTIAL

- Development of a robust governance system in which the citizenry can access its rights and develop a sense of ownership of the development process.
- Effective implementation of public policy and delivery of public services.
- Increase transparency and accountability to prevent vulnerability to corruption and unethical practices and improve public trust in government institutions.
